17 FAQ'S

When is registration?

- Registration runs throughout March, April, and early May.

How do I register?

- Go to www.rbc.org > Academics > 17.

What classes are offered?

- For summer 2019, we will offer British Literature, World History II, Philosophy, and Rocky Online classes.

What is the price of the class?

- Half day classes are \$200.
- Full day classes are \$350.

What is the average class size?

- 5-10 students

What are the dates for the 17 program?

- Classes will begin Tuesday, June 4th and end on Wednesday, June 26th.

Can my student miss some of the 17 term for a family trip or other event?

- Due to the nature of the program, it is vital that your student attend all 17 days of the program. Each day will cover an entire week's worth for half day classes and two weeks' worth of work for full day classes. Therefore, there is a no absence policy for the program. If there is an unavoidable illness, students and parents will need to meet with the teacher and administrator to determine whether or not it is possible to complete the class in the time allotted.

Will this interfere with other RBCS summer activities?

- We have tried to work carefully with all other RBCS programs during the summer, and believe we have accommodations for all eventualities. Sports programs will be adjusted according to the student's availability, and camps should not interfere with the student's schedule. We will do our best to make sure that there are no conflicts before the term begins. Please contact us with specific inquiries

Do these classes count on my transcript?

- Yes. All 17 classes will be graded and recorded exactly as they are in the regular school year.

Can homeschoolers participate?

- Homeschoolers are welcome and encouraged to participate in the program. Please contact homeschool@rbc.org with any questions. Registration for the program will be the same as with full time students.

How will this class affect my child's fall schedule?

- Participants in the 17 program will meet with their counselor to determine the best options for the fall schedule. Typically students replace their 17 class with a study hall and then are able to use both elective times for additional classes. Half day classes will have study hall for the 1st semester, and then continue with a regular schedule. Full day 17 classes will have a study hall for the entire year.
- Some classes will allow acceleration of the schedule as well.

What is the refund policy?

- Refunds for the 17 program will be offered until May 10th only. Due to the anticipated small class sizes and the condensed schedule, no refunds will be given after that point. However, students who must withdraw after the refund deadline will not receive a 'withdraw/fail' on their record; they will simply need to take the class in the fall.
