



## Umbrella Program – Category 1

- RBCS Umbrella students are considered by the State of Florida to be RBCS Private School Students not home education students registered with their local county school district.
- Academic records (grades, testing) maintained by RBCS for all grades.
- Transcripts created for 9-12<sup>th</sup> grades and maintained under NFCEA (Northwest Florida Christian Education Association) the parent organization of RBCS.
- Annual standardized testing submission is required. (Stanford, CAT, ACT, SAT, Pre-ACT, PSAT, Pert, etc).
- *Group* testing of either the Stanford Achievement Test or the CAT (California Achievement Test) is included. Extra fees for individual testing.
- Other tests offered on campus such as the AP, PSAT, ASVAB, and Pre-ACT are available at cost on a space-available basis.
- K-6<sup>th</sup> grades may purchase ½ day blocks of Elementary classes on a space available basis. Tuition applies.
- 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade students may take up to 5 classes per semester at the RBCS Academy on a space available basis. Individual class tuition applies.
- Students may participate in on-campus activities or athletics with same fees as full-time RBCS students.
- Seniors receive a NFCEA diploma with completion of required credits.
- Seniors who earn NFCEA diploma may participate in Senior Activities and Graduation Ceremony with same fees as full-time RBCS students.

## Participation Only Program – Category 2

- Participation Only students are registered with their local county school district as home educated.
- Ideal for students who only wish to participate in activities, athletics, or classes but do not wish to be in the RBCS umbrella program. Some activities such as athletics may be charged a “homeschool participation” fee in addition to any other fees paid by full-time RBCS students.
- Students may take up to 3 classes at the RBCS Academy. Tuition applies.
