

# Refund Policy

All refunds must be approved after submitting an appeals form.

Refunds will be determined based on the following situations/criteria.

## 100% Refund

If a student decides not to participate from time of registration up to one week before the FHSAA start date of the sport registered.

If a student is “cut” (did not make the team) from a tryout.

If a student who is playing a sport in a season that overlaps with an upcoming season and decides to not participate in the upcoming sport *before* the upcoming sport has already *begun*.

## 50% Refund

If a student decides not to participate within a week of the FHSAA start date of the sport registered.

If a student receives a season ending injury while participating in the registered sport before competition/games begin.

If a student who is playing a sport in a season that overlaps with an upcoming season and decides to not participate in the upcoming sport *after* the upcoming sport has already *begun*.

## 0% Refund

If a student quits or decides not to show up on the day or after the FHSAA start date.

If a student is removed from the team by the coach, Athletic Director, or School Administration.

If a student who is playing a sport in a season that overlaps with an upcoming season and decides to not participate in the upcoming sport *after* the upcoming sport has already begun and the previous sport has already *ended*.

## Transfer Policy

Any student eligible for a full refund can have the fee transferred to another season.

If a student who is playing a sport in a season that overlaps with an upcoming season and decides to not participate in the upcoming sport *after* the upcoming sport has already begun.

The only situation this describes is a student playing in a fall sport who registered for a winter sport, but then forgoes the winter sport and wants to participate in a spring sport.

If a student receives a season-ending injury between the FHSAA start date and the first competition then a transfer to another sport may be applied.
