



Visitor Protocol for Rocky Bayou Christian School

RBCS recognizes that parent involvement and participation on campus is a distinct and valuable part of our partnership with you. As we make every effort to keep your student safe, secure, and healthy while on campus, we are limiting student contact with visitors when possible.

All guests will be checked for temperature as they enter a building on campus. Any guest with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be required to exit campus. Visitors will be required to wear masks as appropriate.

Quick Visits:

- When checking a student in (late arrivals) or out (early dismissal) or bringing an item to your student, we ask that you call the specific Departmental office and allow a staff member to assist you. Please pull up to the pickup area and do not park.

Visiting a student for lunch:

- Please limit the number of guests at lunch to one if possible.
- Please park in a visitor parking space.
- Make arrangements with your student's teacher at least 24 hours ahead of time if possible.
- If the class is eating inside, please plan to eat with your student outside at a picnic table or in your vehicle. If the class is eating outside, you may sit with your student at a table apart from other students or in your vehicle. The conference room may also be available on the Crestview campus. When you arrive, please enter through the appropriate office for a temp check and visitor's pass.

Parent/Teacher Conferences:

- Our teachers and administrators are available to conference with you about your student at scheduled times. These conferences can either take place in person or virtually. Please email the teacher directly or contact the appropriate administrator to schedule an appointment.
- As always, we ask that you not drop in for spontaneous meetings; our teachers prefer to give you their undivided attention.
